

## Teacher Program Overview Lights! Camera! Action! – Prep

**Program Duration:** 45 minutes **Minimum Participants:** 20 Students

## **Program Overview:**

In alignment with the Australian Curriculum for Drama and Health and Physical Education, this program will cater for the educational needs of Prep students. This interactive program will allow the students to engage and explore the importance of the elements of Drama focusing on confidence, characterisation and improvisation. Students will have the opportunity to learn and practise the skills needed to use the elements of Drama, including voice, facial expressions, movement and focus, as well as explore the idea that Drama is a way to share ideas and communicate with the audience. The students will have the opportunity to apply their knowledge and understanding and practise their improvisation skills. Many of the elements for Drama also link to the Foundation years Health and Physical Education curriculum, such as movement skills, being respectful and being confidence in making social interactions with peers.
